

Safety & Security at the Asian Champs

4 July 2007

The Thailand Tigers have engaged Chubb Security as Safety and Security advisors for the event with particular focus on provision of a :

1. Emergency Evacuation Plan
2. Lightening Evacuation Plan
3. Bag Inspection Plan.

Chubb have completed an inspection of the ground and completed a Risk Assessment Analysis which currently scores LOW. They will conduct another assessment a few days prior to the event. Should this assessment change we will advise of any changes to current plans.

A summary of the plans as they affect the players is below and we ask you forward this email to all touring members prior to arrival in Bangkok.

In the unlikely scenario of a security incident...

Emergency Evacuation Plan

1. A series of blasts on air horn followed by loud speaker announcement will suspend play.
2. Players leave the ground via Emergency Exit gate behind grandstand - leave all bags behind (gate will be sign-posted and is where you will enter the ground from buses on arrival)
3. Assembly area will be on side road (this leaves main entrance open for emergency vehicle access)
4. One member of your touring party to do a headcount and advise chief marshall if anyone unaccounted for.
5. Wait for further instructions.

Lightening Evacuation Plan

1. A single long blast on air horn followed by loudspeaker announcement will suspend play
2. Players leave the ground via Emergency Exit gate behind grandstand.
3. Players go to team bus and get inside bus.
4. Wait for further instruction.

Do not -

1. Stay outside if suitable shelter is available
2. Shelter under a tree
3. Stand in or near water
4. Use showers, or any plumbing facilities during a storm
5. Hold/touch metal objects
6. Stand close to windows, water, electric sockets
7. Make telephone calls on landlines
8. Use electrical appliances
9. Be near a connected TV
10. Go to unsafe shelter areas such as close to outdoor metal objects like flag poles, fences and gates, high mast light poles, metal bleachers, golf cars, machinery, etc.

Do -

1. Get under cover - but stay away from windows and open doors
2. Get in a vehicle - with the windows wound up but do NOT touch the sides of the vehicle

Random Bag Inspection

1. Chubb will provide two teams of security personal who will conduct random bag inspections throughout the day. Players are asked to co-operate fully if approached.
2. Chubb Security will conduct boundary patrols during the day

We trust none of the above will be required on the day but seek your assistance in ensuring we have a great and safe Asian Championships
